A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Daniel Williams; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Daniel Williams; and

4 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
5 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state, as evidenced
6 dramatically by his many years of superlative service with the Division of Family and
7 Children Services, where he served as a case worker; and

8 WHEREAS, a dedicated member of the community, he further served with Habitat for
9 Humanity, the Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta, Leadership Atlanta, Central
10 Atlanta Progress, the Atlanta Downtown Neighborhood Association, and the University of
11 Georgia, exemplifying his passion for ensuring the well-being of his fellow citizens; and

12 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman motivated countless volunteers through
13 organizations and campaigns that promoted civil liberties, voting rights, mental health, public
14 transportation, environmental science, and government ethics; and

15 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
16 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
17 family and friends were admired by others; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
19 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
20 made this world a better place in which to live; and

21 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man with a unique sense of humor, Daniel
22 Williams will long be remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will
23 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Daniel Williams and
26 express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
