A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-11-62 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 eavesdropping, surveillance, or intercepting communication which invades privacy of
- 3 another, and divulging private message, so as to provide for limitations regarding the use of
- 4 electronic monitoring devices; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 5 for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-11-62 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to eavesdropping,
- 9 surveillance, or intercepting communication which invades privacy of another, and divulging
- 10 private message, is amended by revising paragraph (7) as follows:
- 11 "(7) Any person to intentionally and in a clandestine manner place any mobile global
- positioning system monitoring device or any other electronic monitoring device to track
- the physical location of an adult person without the consent of such person, and to
- 14 commit any other acts of a nature similar to those set out in paragraphs (1) through (6)
- of this Code section which invade the privacy of another."
