A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 general provisions regarding state government, so as to prohibit state and local governments  
3 from mandating vaccine passports; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters;  
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general  
8 provisions regarding state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as  
9 follows:

10 "50-1-11.

11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'Agency' means:

12 (1) Every state department, agency, board, bureau, office, commission, public  
13 corporation, and authority;

14 (2) Every county, municipal corporation, school district, or other political subdivision  
15 of this state;

16 (3) Every department, agency, board, bureau, office, commission, authority, or similar  
17 body of each such county, municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of this  
18 state; and

19 (4) Every city, county, regional, or other authority established pursuant to the laws of this  
20 state.

21 (b)(1) No agency shall require proof of any vaccination of any person as a condition of  
22 providing any service or access to any facility, issuing any license, permit, or other type  
23 of authorization, or performing any duty of such agency.

24 (2) No agency, through any rule, regulation, ordinance, resolution, or other action shall  
25 require that any person or private entity require proof of vaccination of any person as a  
26 condition of providing any service or access to any facility, or as a condition of such  
27 person or private entity's performance of any regular activity by such person or private  
28 entity."

29 **SECTION 2.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
