1 *Amend SR 596 (LC 39 3374S) by inserting between lines 206 and 207 the following:*

2 WHEREAS, Beatrice W. Rumley, was born in Rising Fawn, Georgia, on January 8, 1932,  
3 the beloved daughter of Charles W. and Ruth Hester Williams; and

4 WHEREAS, Ralph H. Rumley was born in Pulaski County, Virginia, on November 21, 1928,  
5 and served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United States Navy,  
6 spending most of his military service in Adak, Alaska; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Rumley was employed with the Combustion Engineering Company for 28  
8 years, and the couple owned and operated the Georgia Game Park just north of Rising Fawn;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, a couple with deep and abiding faith, Mr. Rumley was an active member of  
11 Rising Fawn United Methodist Church, and Mrs. Rumley faithfully attended Rising Fawn  
12 Baptist Church; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Rumley served on the board of education, was very active with school  
14 activities and sports, belonged to several organizations, and was a Mason and Shriner; and

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rumley was past Worthy Matron of the Order of Eastern Star Dade  
16 County Chapter #476 and a charter member of the Tri-State Cattlemen's Association; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished couple  
18 be recognized appropriately by dedicating an interchange in their memory.

20 WHEREAS, Mayor Ray Crowder is known in Chickamauga, Georgia, for his dedication to  
21 public service; and

22 WHEREAS, Mayor Crowder has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours  
23 of his time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as  
24 evidenced by his superlative service as a city council member and mayor for over 40 years;

26 WHEREAS, in addition to his service in city government, Mayor Crowder has demonstrated  
27 his commitment to improving the lives of Chickamaugans as the city's fire chief and as a  
28 school board member; and

29 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
30 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting lives during the Korean conflict; and

31 WHEREAS, Mayor Crowder founded Ray Crowder Service, an appliance and  
32 heating-and-air-conditioning service business, and he and his brother owned and operated  
33 Crowder Supply Company for 36 years; and

34 WHEREAS, his vision and unyielding commitment to others and the citizens of  
35 Chickamauga has set the standard for public service; and

36 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
37 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an  
38 intersection in his honor.

45 and Euclid Avenue in Walker County is dedicated as The Honorable Mayor Ray Crowder
