

Senator Mullis of the 53rd the following amendment:

1 *Amend SR 596 (LC 39 3374S) by inserting between lines 206 and 207 the following:*

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens with the passing of Mrs. Doris
3 Greene Mullis; and

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mullis was born in LaFayette, Georgia, the beloved daughter of Reverend
5 Gordon Lee and Eunice Graham Greene; and

6 WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Walker County, Mrs. Mullis worked at Crystal Springs
7 mill and inspired future leaders as a teacher at Osburn Elementary and substitute teacher for
8 Chickamauga City Schools; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mullis devoted her time, talent, and energy for over 30 years to serving
10 those with developmental disabilities as a case manager with Lookout Mountain Community
11 Services; and

12 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Mullis was an active and devoted
13 member of First Baptist Church of Chickamauga; and

14 WHEREAS, her leadership and guidance were invaluable to numerous organizations,
15 including the Cherokee Library Board, Chickamauga Public Schools Parent Teacher
16 Association, and Chickamauga American Legion Ladies Auxiliary; and

17 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
19 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
21 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in her memory.

22 **PART XIII**

23 WHEREAS, Congressman Gordon Lee has long been recognized by the citizens of this state
24 for the vital role that he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
25 welfare of the citizens of Georgia and the United States; and

26 WHEREAS, Congressman Gordon Lee was born on May 29, 1859, near Ringgold, Georgia,
27 and graduated from Emory College in 1880; and

28 WHEREAS, Congressman Lee was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in 1894
29 and served as a member of the Georgia Senate from 1902 to 1904; and

30 WHEREAS, he was appointed to the State memorial board by Governor William Atkinson
31 and served as a member of the National Forest Reservation Commission; and

32 WHEREAS, Congressman Lee served in the United States House of Representatives from
33 1905 to 1927; and

34 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
35 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an
36 intersection in his memory.

38 *By inserting between lines 237 and 238 the following:*

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ENACTED that the intersection of U.S. 27 and Pearl
40 Drive in Walker County is dedicated as the Doris Greene Mullis Memorial Intersection.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ENACTED that the intersection of State Route 341
42 and Gordon Street/10th Street in Walker County is dedicated as the Congressman Gordon
43 Lee Memorial Intersection.
