

## Senate Resolution 720

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jen Jordan on her outstanding public service as a senator; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jen Jordan has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital  
4 role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of  
5 the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Jen Jordan was elected to the senate in a special election in 2017 and represents  
7 Georgia's 6th Senate District, which includes portions of Cobb and Fulton Counties; and

8 WHEREAS, Senator Jordan serves as chairman of the Senate Special Judiciary Committee  
9 and as a member of the Senate Banking and Financial Institutions, Government Oversight,  
10 Interstate Cooperation, Science and Technology, and Reapportionment and Redistricting  
11 Committees; and

12 WHEREAS, from kindergarten to law school, Jen Jordan is a product of Georgia's public  
13 education system; she obtained her bachelor's degree from Georgia Southern University and  
14 went on to graduate magna cum laude from the University of Georgia School of Law, where

15 she was a member of the Georgia Law Review and the school's award winning National  
16 Moot Court Team; and

17 WHEREAS, after graduating, Senator Jordan served as a federal law clerk to United States  
18 District Court Judge Anthony A. Alaimo; and

19 WHEREAS, Senator Jordan was named to *Georgia trend* magazine's "40 Under 40" list that  
20 recognizes Georgia's leaders under the age of 40 in "commercial, cultural, academic, and  
21 governmental institutions"; she was also recognized by the University of Georgia as one of  
22 its "40 Under 40" alumni, as well as receiving a similar recognition by Fulton County; and

23 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,  
24 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced  
25 dramatically by her superlative service with the Georgia General Assembly; and

26 WHEREAS, Jen Jordan's significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable  
27 patience and diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of  
28 this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
30 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
32 recognize and commend Jen Jordan for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated  
33 public service to the State of Georgia and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued  
34 health and happiness.
