A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the 2022 Georgia Farm Working Families at the Capitol; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the agricultural sector contributes approximately \$73.3 billion annually to
4 Georgia's economy; and

5 WHEREAS, one in seven Georgians work in agriculture, forestry, or related fields; and

6 WHEREAS, it is because of the hard work and dedication of farm workers that Georgians
7 and residents of surrounding states have food that nourishes our bodies and minds every day;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, out of the Georgia Farm Working Families, 100 percent care about access and
10 affordability of higher education as their first priority; and

11 WHEREAS, 90 percent have housing affordability as a priority and say access to doctors and
12 treatments is a priority; and

13 WHEREAS, 70 percent say their priority is good wages, and 40 percent say their priority is
14 food security; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these farm workers and their families be
16 recognized for their hard work and dedication to Georgia.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize and commend the 2022 Georgia Farm Working Families
19 at the Capitol.

21 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
22 2022 Georgia Farm Working Families.
