A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Atlanta Braves; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021, the Atlanta Braves claimed their first World Series title
3 since 1995 after shutting down the Houston Astros 7-0, finishing the series with four wins
4 and two losses; and

5 WHEREAS, after securing an early lead, the Braves utilized their superior pitching and
6 landed numerous home runs in order to close out the game, allowing the Astros only six hits
7 and three at-bats with runners in scoring position; and

8 WHEREAS, Jorge Soler was named the 2021 World Series MVP for his outstanding
9 performance, joining the ranks of Hank Aaron, Lonnie Smith, and Ryan Klesko; and

10 WHEREAS, this victory gives the City of Atlanta its first major professional sports league
11 championship title since Atlanta United won the MLS Cup in 2018; and

12 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
13 athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and unity of purpose and spirit of each member of the
14 team; and

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15 WHEREAS, as this magnificent team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by
16 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is
17 abundantly proper to call them champions.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 congratulate the Atlanta Braves for winning the 2021 World Series title and extend sincere
20 best wishes for continued success on the field and beyond.
