A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Atlanta Braves; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, on October 23, 2021, the Atlanta Braves defeated the Dodgers 4-2 in Game 6
3 of the National League Championship (NLCS), winning their first pennant since 1999 and
4 securing their place at the World Series; and

5 WHEREAS, finishing the NLCS with a .560 batting average, 14 hits, nine RBIs, and three
6 home runs, Eddie Rosario was recognized as the NLCS MVP, the first Braves player to win
7 the title since Eddie Perez; and

8 WHEREAS, acquired as a result of trades made by General Manager Alex Anthopoulos
9 following injuries sustained by Ronald Acuña Jr. and Mike Soroka, Eddie Rosario energized
10 the Braves' offense throughout the NLCS; and

11 WHEREAS, excellent play, superior teamwork, and extraordinary resilience have made this
12 team a spectacular one to observe throughout the season; and

13 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
14 athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and unity of purpose and spirit of each member of the
15 team; and

16 WHEREAS, the Braves have earned their well-deserved reputation for excellence by
17 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, and it is
18 abundantly proper to call them champions.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize and commend the Atlanta Braves for their stellar athletic performance during the
21 National League Championship and extend sincere best wishes for many more victories.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
