## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Community Supervision Officer Lisa Garcia, the Department  
2 of Community Supervision 2022 Officer of the Year; and for other purposes.

4 of Community Supervision commenced operations on July 1, 2015, through the passage of  
5 House Bill 310; and

8 department's core values of selfless service, accountability, integrity, teamwork, and
