A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Deputy Emory A. Rowland and dedicating a road in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Deputy Emory A. Rowland was highly regarded by the citizens of his
4 community and state and by local government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity
5 and dedication to the sound principles of law enforcement; and

6 WHEREAS, Deputy Rowland diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of
7 his time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service as a deputy in Johnson County; and

9 WHEREAS, Deputy Rowland led an exceptional career of public of service, always putting
10 public safety and the citizens of Johnson County first, and his inspiring commitment to the
11 welfare of others stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement
12 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others; and

13 WHEREAS, Deputy Rowland exhibited extraordinary devotion to public service,
14 outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties and

15 it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be
16 recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 57 East from Mile Marker 15
19 to the Johnson/Emanuel County Line in Johnson County, Georgia, is dedicated as the Deputy
20 Emory Rowland Memorial Highway.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Deputy Emory Rowland
23 Memorial Highway.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
25 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
26 family of Deputy Emory A. Rowland and to the Department of Transportation.
