A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 10 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 barbers and cosmetologists, so as to allow a licensed master barber or barber II to operate a
3 mobile barber shop under certain conditions; to provide for the promulgation of rules and
4 regulations by the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbers; to provide for related matters;
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Chapter 10 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to barbers and
9 cosmetologists, is amended by revising Code Section 43-10-18.1, previously designated as
10 reserved, as follows:

11 "43-10-18.1.

12 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the board shall issue and renew a
13 license to operate a mobile barber shop to any individual licensed as a master barber or
14 barber II who can show that such mobile barber shop provides and maintains such physical
15 and sanitary facilities and equipment as shall be required by rules and regulations
16 promulgated by the board. Only barbering and no other service or business shall be

17 conducted from a mobile barber shop. A mobile barber shop shall be subject to such
18 business licenses, health and sanitation standards, and other requirements imposed upon
19 stationary barber shops by ordinance or resolution of each county and municipality in
20 which such mobile barbershop operates. Mobile barber shops shall not train barber
21 apprentices.
