

ADOPTED

Senator Dolezal of the 27th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Education and Youth substitute to SB 233 (LC 49 1388S)*
 2 *by replacing line 12 with the following:*

3 to provide for audits by the Department of Audits and Accounts; to provide for an annual
 4 report by the Office of Student Achievement; to provide for a short title;

5 *By replacing lines 67 through 70 with the following:*

6 (2) The student resides in the attendance zone of a public school that is included on the
 7 list of public schools provided for in Code Section 20-2B-10;

8 (3) The student does not meet any of the ineligibility criteria provided for in
 9 subsection (b) of Code Section 20-3-519.1;

10 (4) The student's parent signs an agreement promising:

11 *By replacing "(4)" with "(5)" on line 77.*

12 *By deleting the quotation mark at the end of line 279 and inserting after line 279 the*
 13 *following:*

14 20-2B-10.

15 (a) In the annual report required by paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of Code
 16 Section 20-14-27, the Office of Student Achievement shall include a separate list of public
 17 schools that performed in the lowest 25 percent of all public schools based on individual
 18 school ratings as provided for in subsection (d) of Code Section 20-14-33, provided that
 19 in the event of a tied rating, the public school with the lower performance in student
 20 achievement shall be prioritized.

21 (b) By December 1 of each year, the Office of Student Achievement shall publish the list
22 provided for in subsection (a) of this Code section on its website."
