Senators Cowsert of the 46th, Albers of the 56th, Dugan of the 30th, Still of the 48th, Robertson of the 29th, and others offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism substitute to HB 353*
 2 *(LC 36 5579S) by adding "subsections (a) and (b) and" after "revising" on line 243.*

3 *By adding between lines 246 and 247 the following:*

4 *"(a) Upon successful implementation and certification of the Class B accounting terminal*
 5 *under the provisions of Code Section 50-27-101, and for the first fiscal year thereafter, the*
 6 *corporation shall:*

7 *(1) Retain ~~5~~ 35 percent of the net receipts;*

8 *(2) Provide, within five business days of receipt, ~~47.5~~ 32.5 percent of the net receipts to*
 9 *the location owner and location operator for the cost associated with allowing the Class*
 10 *B machines to be placed; and*

11 *(3) Provide, within five business days of receipt, ~~47.5~~ 32.5 percent of the net receipts to*
 12 *the operator holding the Class B master license for the cost of securing, operating, and*
 13 *monitoring the machines.*

14 *~~(b) In each fiscal year after the implementation and certification required by subsection (a)~~*
 15 *~~of this Code section, the corporation's share shall increase 1 percent, taken evenly from the~~*
 16 *~~location owner or location operator and the operator, to a maximum of 10 percent.~~*
 17 *Reserved."*
