12 leadership and are positive role models for young women in the Girl Scouts program and
13 throughout this state; and

14 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by these exceptional young
15 leaders have set an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in their futures; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these outstanding Girl Scouts be
17 appropriately honored.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend the Wilson Creek Girl Scouts for their
20 diligence and efforts on behalf of those in need and extend best wishes for future success.
