

Senators Cowsert of the 46th, Walker of the 20th, Tillery of the 19th, Albers of the 56th, Robertson of the 29th and others offered the following amendment #3:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism substitute to HB 237*  
2 *(LC 36 5577S) by replacing "means a major league professional team:" with "means a major*  
3 *league professional team that plays baseball, football, basketball, hockey, or soccer." on line*  
4 *198 and deleting lines 199 through 202.*

5 *By replacing "'Type 1 eligible entity' means any of the following:" with "Reserved." on line*  
6 *256 and deleting lines 257 through 268.*

7 *By replacing "a Type 1 eligible" with "an" on line 271.*

8 *By replacing lines 462 through 466 with the following:*  
9 *of \$1 million;*

10 *By replacing lines 469 through 473 with the following:*  
11 *of \$100,000.00; and*

12 *By replacing lines 528 and 529 with the following:*

13 *(2) A professional sports team or an employee of a professional sports team;*

14 *(2.1) An individual or entity that has an ownership interest of 5 percent or more in a*  
15 *professional sports team or an employee of such individual or entity;*

16 *By replacing lines 558 through 564 with the following:*

17 (a) A Type 1 sports betting license authorizes a Type 1 sports betting licensee, or its  
18 designated online sports services provider, to offer online sports betting. The corporation  
19 shall establish a procedure for a Type 1 entity to designate an online sports betting  
20 provider.

21 *By replacing lines 565 through 577 with the following:*

22 (b)(1) The corporation shall issue no fewer than six Type 1 sports betting licenses to  
23 qualified applicants able to meet the duties of a license holder under this article and that  
24 the corporation determines will be best able to maximize tax revenue for the state;  
25 provided, however, that, if fewer than six qualified applicants seek Type 1 sports betting  
26 licenses, the corporation shall issue as many Type 1 sports betting licenses as there are  
27 qualified applicants, and the absence of six issued Type 1 sports betting licenses shall not  
28 preclude Type 1 sports betting licensees from offering online sports betting. If a Type  
29 1 sports betting license is revoked, expires, or otherwise becomes ineffective, such Type  
30 1 sports betting license shall not be included in the number of Type 1 sports betting  
31 licenses issued.

32 (2) Although six is the minimum number of Type 1 sports betting licenses the  
33 corporation shall issue, there is no maximum limitation.

34 (3) One of the Type 1 sports betting licenses shall be issued to the corporation, which,  
35 as the master licensee, shall be authorized through a designated online sports betting  
36 services provider to offer online sports betting.

37 *By replacing "Type 1 eligible entity" with "Type 1 sports betting licensee" on lines 578 and*  
38 *579.*

39 *By deleting lines 580 through 588 and lines 594 through 598.*

40 *By replacing line 589 with the following:*
