A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Jacqueline Mohair; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, during the challenging times of the COVID-19 pandemic, Trinity Girls Network
3 Corp. was awarded a significant contract to provide essential sustenance to more than 50,000
4 families in Gwinnett County, delivering food boxes to individuals in need; and

5 WHEREAS, in recognition of a decade of unwavering commitment to promoting peace and
6 acknowledging extraordinary individuals, this legislative body hereby commemorates
7 Ambassador for Peace Dr. Jacqueline Mohair for her outstanding efforts in philanthropy and
8 global outreach; and

9 WHEREAS, as the chief NGO ambassador to the United Nations, Dr. Jacqueline Mohair has
10 played a crucial role in instigating positive global change through her organizations, Trinity
11 Girls Network Corp. and Trinity International University of Ambassadors (TIUA) School of
12 Business, both of which hold Special Consultative ECOSOC status with the United Nations;

14 WHEREAS, Ambassador Dr. Jacqueline Mohair, leading Trinity Girls Network, initiated a
15 mentorship program in Zambia, Africa, in 2023, demonstrating a profound commitment to
16 empowering lives on a global scale; and

17 WHEREAS, Dr. Mohair, a distinguished transformational business & life strategist,
18 advocate, professor, life coach, minister, and serial entrepreneur, has significantly
19 contributed to the realms of education, entrepreneurship, and empowerment; and

20 WHEREAS, as an accomplished author, Dr. Mohair has penned inspirational books on
21 empowerment and entrepreneurship, serving as a guiding light for women from all walks of
22 life, teaching them to triumph through faith; and

23 WHEREAS, Ambassador Dr. Mohair, a premier life coach, has been pivotal in helping
24 women turn their passion into profits, advocating for positive change, and empowering
25 individuals to succeed in both life and business; and

26 WHEREAS, achieving the prestigious status of a ten-time Amazon No. 1 Best Selling
27 Author, Dr. Jacqueline Mohair has collaborated on ten anthology books, showcasing her
28 significant literary impact; and

29 WHEREAS, propelled by a passion to fulfill a divine mandate during these turbulent times,
30 Dr. Mohair has authored 21 books, consistently encouraging individuals to deepen their
31 intimacy with God and rise to their divine appointment, calling, and destiny; and

32 WHEREAS, Ambassador Dr. Jacqueline Mohair's commitment to humanitarian service is
33 evident through her co-founding of Trinity Girls Network, actively representing the United

34 Nations in fostering sustainable economic empowerment for women and girls by promoting
35 entrepreneurship and education; and

37 entrepreneur, Dr. Jacqueline Mohair has impacted hundreds of small business owners,
38 corporate professionals, and nonprofits, achieving top positions in three network marketing

41 President Barack Obama Lifetime Achievement Award, the 2018 45th President Lifetime
42 Achievement Award, and the 2021 Biden/Harris Lifetime Achievement Award as well as the
43 Outstanding Georgia Citizen Award from the Georgia Secretary of State's Office; and

44 WHEREAS, Dr. Mohair holds multiple degrees including a Doctorate of Ministry and
45 Leadership from the Canadian International University & Seminary, two honorary doctorate
46 degrees in divinity, a Doctorate of Business Administration (DBA) with a special
47 concentration in international business from Argosy University, and a master's degree in
48 internet marketing from Full Sail University; and

49 WHEREAS, her commitment to education is further exemplified by her bachelor's degree
50 in business administration with a minor in marketing from Mississippi State University, a
51 master's degree in educational leadership from Argosy University, and her active
52 involvement as a John C. Maxwell Certified Coach; and

54 on the Forbes Business Council and as a member of ForbesBLK, receiving the Black

55 Excellence Award from the State of Texas and hosting annual panels and events at the

58 Vienna, Austria, underscoring her global influence and commitment to positive change; and

59 WHEREAS, in her personal life, Dr. Jacqueline Mohair, married to Dr. H.T. Mohair for 20
60 years, is a proud parent of four children and seven grandchildren; and

61 WHEREAS, Dr. Mohair also serves on the Board of the Whitney E. Houston Legacy
62 Foundation, further solidifying her commitment to the legacy and impact of the legendary
63 Whitney Houston; and

64 WHEREAS, she holds a pastoral role at the Rock Hill Church under the leadership of Dr.
65 Sonnie Badu, contributing to the spiritual well-being and growth of the congregation.
