

ADOPTED

Senators Dolezal of the 27th and Still of the 28th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend SB 208 (LC 49 1280) by replacing lines 77 through 80 with the following:*

2 (g) Before adopting a resolution to impose, levy, and collect educational development
3 impact fees as provided in this article, the local board of education shall require a local
4 referendum of the qualified voters residing within the limits of the local school system.
5 Such referendum shall be held at the next regularly scheduled general election or as may
6 otherwise be authorized at an earlier date by the local board of education. Such referendum
7 shall be held for the purpose of deciding whether the local board of education shall be
8 authorized to expend funds from the levy and collection of educational development impact
9 fees to offset bonded indebtedness, educational special purpose local option sales taxes,
10 millage rates, and other tax burdens on citizens residing in the area served by the school
11 system. The ballot question shall be approved by the local board of education.

12 (h) Subject to approval of the referendum provided for in subsection (g) of this Code
13 section, the local board of education shall adopt a resolution approving an educational
14 development impact fee schedule. Such fee schedule shall be sent to each local
15 government in the area served by the school system.

16 (i) Subject to approval of the referendum provided for in subsection (g) of this Code
17 section, each local government in the area served by the school system shall collect
