A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Matthew Christopher Littlefield; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most beloved citizens with
3 the passing of Matthew Christopher Littlefield on March 2, 2024, at 38 years old; and
- 4 WHEREAS, raised in a family dominated by strong female figures, Matthew's relationships
5 with his older sisters, his doting mother and grandmother, and his revered father formed the
6 foundation of his character and life; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Matthew's commitment to others extended from his childhood as a Ghostbusters
8 enthusiast and an athlete on Sandy Creek's football team to his years at the University of
9 Georgia, where he not only earned a degree but also gained countless lifelong friendships;

- 11 WHEREAS, Matthew spent his professional life advocating for many causes he believed in
12 at the Georgia State Capitol; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Matthew's genuine ability to see and hear people was cherished by many and
14 brought him much success; and

15 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his humor, empathy, and deep concern for
16 his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
17 family and friends were admired by others; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
19 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
20 made this world a better place in which to live; and

21 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Matthew Christopher Littlefield will long
22 be remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all
23 who had the great fortune of knowing him.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 join in honoring the life and memory of Matthew Christopher Littlefield and express their
26 deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
