A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Kenyatta Mitchell; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Kenyatta Mitchell has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable
3 hours of her time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as
4 evidenced dramatically by her superlative service as director of intergovernmental affairs for
5 the City of Atlanta; and

6 WHEREAS, during her distinguished tenure, she has successfully defended the city against
7 divisive legislation, secured more than \$350 million in federal resources, and played a pivotal
8 role in crafting the Mega Tax Credit, facilitating over \$1 billion in claims for large economic
9 development projects; and

10 WHEREAS, prior to her current position as director, she held the role of vice president of
11 government affairs at HNTB and served as a principal at a government affair consulting firm;

13 WHEREAS, she has further served her community as part of the boards of numerous
14 nonprofit organizations, including Georgia Prospers, Keep Atlanta Beautiful, the Georgia
15 Equality Board, and the Atlanta Business League; and

16 WHEREAS, Kenyatta's professional accomplishments include recognition as one of
17 Georgia's top 20 lobbyists by the National Black Professional Lobbyists Association,
18 acknowledgment as a Champion of Equity by Georgia Equality, and consistent recognition
19 as a top lobbyist by the Georgia Professional Lobbyists Association; and

20 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
21 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
23 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize and commend Kenyatta Mitchell for her efficient,
26 effective, unselfish, and dedicated service to the State of Georgia as well as extend the most
27 sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
