

**ADOPTED**

Senators Dixon of the 45th, Kirkpatrick of the 32nd, Gooch of the 51st, Robertson of the 29th, and Albers of the 56th offered the following amendment #1:

1 *Amend the substitute to HB 1073 (LC 47 3013S) by inserting following "dependency;" on*  
2 *line 5 the following:*

3 to amend Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
4 provisions applicable to counties and municipal corporations, so as to prohibit local  
5 governments from requiring the placement of video surveillance equipment at locations  
6 where the retail sale of automotive gasoline occurs;

7 *By inserting between lines 140 and 141 the following:*

8 **SECTION 1-A.**

9 Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to provisions  
10 applicable to counties and municipal corporations, is amended by adding a new Code section  
11 to read as follows:

12 "36-60-32.

13 A county, municipal corporation, or consolidated government shall not require the  
14 placement of video surveillance equipment in the interior or exterior of any business or  
15 location where the retail sale of automotive gasoline, as that term is defined in Code  
16 Section 10-1-232, occurs."
