

ADOPTED

Representatives Stinson of the 150th and Seabaugh of the 34th offer the following amendment:

Amend the Senate substitute to HB 1303 (HB 1303/SCSFA) by replacing all language from line 1 through the end with the following:

To amend Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, so as to establish a specialty license plate honoring the Shepherd Center and provide for disposition of funds to the Shepherd Center; to establish a specialty license plate honoring Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., and provide for the disposition of funds to the Delta Life Development Center; to provide for the issuance of separate license plates for hearses and ambulances; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide for compliance with constitutional requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, is amended in Code Section 40-2-86, relating to special license plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation, by adding new paragraphs to subsection (l) to read as follows:

“(71) A special license plate honoring the Shepherd Center. The funds raised by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed to Shepherd Center, Inc.

(72) A special license plate honoring Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. The funds raised by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed to the Delta Life Development Center."

SECTION 2.

Said chapter is further amended in subsection (a) of Code Section 40-2-151, relating to annual license fees for operation of vehicles, fee for permanent licensing of certain trailers, and fee for new passenger car with paid title ad valorem taxes, by revising paragraph (12) and adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

"(12) For each motor driven hearse or ambulance	20.00
<u>(12.1) For each motor driven ambulance</u>	<u>20.00"</u>

SECTION 3.

This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025.

SECTION 4.

In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

SECTION 5.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
