A RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, the Corporate Volunteer Council (CVC) of Atlanta supports member companies

6 in the nation recognized three times as CVC of the Year by Points of Light, a nonpartisan
7 international social impact organization; and

9 Foundation as President, Brittany Church of Ryan LLC as Vice President, Kat Reynolds of
10 Veritiv as Secretary, Geneva Hall-Shelton of IHG Hotels and Resorts as Treasurer, and
11 Toccara Arnold Alam as Community Volunteer, all of whom bring diverse expertise and
12 unwavering dedication to corporate excellence; and

13 WHEREAS, members of the CVC benefit from forums that focus on best practices for
14 corporate community engagement and gain access to educational programming, networking,
15 and leadership development opportunities; and

16 WHEREAS, the CVC further provides annual benefits such as industry-specific interest
17 groups, access to nonprofit partnerships, and recognition opportunities through the IMPACT
18 Awards and other press features; and

20 corporations such as Delta Air Lines, Deloitte, and Amazon, alongside nonprofit
21 organizations like United Way of Greater Atlanta; and

23 impact and professional growth through their commitment to volunteerism and community
24 engagement.
