15 administrator as well as an exemplary history and political science teacher, and his
16 sponsorship of the school's model United Nations program guided them to national
17 championships; and

18 WHEREAS, his unique coaching style and sense of humor have fostered an environment that
19 cultivates student and athletic growth, and he has left a long-lasting impact on the community
20 through his dedicated service.
