A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Leadership Lowndes and Leadership Lowndes Youth for their
2 contributions towards community involvement and awareness, developing leaders, and
3 showing passion for action for over 35 years; and for other purposes.

5 development of Lowndes County, Georgia; and

7 exposing existing and emerging leaders to local challenges and opportunities, building

9 members for a more active role in community leadership; and

14 featuring speakers and discussions on present-day issues; and

15 WHEREAS, the Leadership Lowndes Youth Initiative provides high school students with
16 valuable opportunities to develop leadership skills, address teen issues, and engage in
17 community service; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding contributions of this
19 extraordinary organization be appropriately honored.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize and commend Leadership Lowndes and Leadership Lowdes Youth for their
22 dedication to fostering community engagement, developing leaders, and driving meaningful
23 change.
