18 have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

20 vision and unyielding commitment to operational excellence will be sorely missed upon the  
21 occasion of her retirement; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
23 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
