A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and congratulating Georgia Peace Officers Standards and Training Council's
2 Executive Director Michael T. Ayers upon being awarded Georgia's Outstanding Police
3 Chief of the Year; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Executive Director Michael T. Ayers began his career in 1989 with the Hartwell
5 Police Department and subsequently joined the Georgia Bureau of Investigation in 1990,
6 rising to the rank of Special Agent in Charge; and

7 WHEREAS, he was appointed to the position of Executive Director of the Georgia Peace
8 Officers Standards and Training Council (POST) by Governor Brian P. Kemp on May 15,
9 2019; and

10 WHEREAS, Director Ayers graduated from the University of Georgia with a Bachelor of
11 Arts in criminal justice; and

12 WHEREAS, Director Ayers has graduated from advanced law enforcement leadership
13 programs such as the FBI National Academy, the Georgia Law Enforcement Professional
14 Management Program, and the Georgia International Law Enforcement Exchange Program;

16 WHEREAS, Director Ayers is a member of and has served as President of the International
17 Association of Directors of Law Enforcement Standards and Training; and

18 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Director Ayers, POST operations were modernized, and
19 he significantly contributed to the safety and efficiency of law enforcement throughout
20 Georgia while acknowledging the recruiting and retention challenges facing law enforcement
21 executives; and

22 WHEREAS, Director Ayers retired from service to the citizens of Georgia on January 2,
23 2025; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to recognize the impactful changes at POST,
25 which benefit all law enforcement as well as the citizens of the State of Georgia, brought
26 about by the visionary leadership of Executive Director Michael T. Ayers.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
28 the members of this body recognize and congratulate Georgia Peace Officers Standards and
29 Training Council's Executive Director Michael T. Ayers upon being awarded Georgia's
30 Outstanding Police Chief of the Year.
