## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 11, 2025, as the Interfaith Children's Movement's 14th Annual Day  
2 at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Interfaith Children's Movement (ICM) has been a steadfast advocate for  
4 Georgia's children since its founding in 2001, uniting people of all faiths to create a better  
5 future by mobilizing communities across the state to champion policies that promote child  
6 well-being, justice, and equity; and

7 WHEREAS, through its advocacy efforts, ICM has played a pivotal role in securing vital  
8 protections for Georgia's children, from expanding access to healthcare to strengthening  
9 juvenile justice reforms; and

10 WHEREAS, by fostering collaboration among faith leaders, policymakers, and grassroots  
11 organizers, ICM has built a movement that speaks with a unified voice on behalf of the most  
12 vulnerable; and

13 WHEREAS, the organization's dedication extends beyond policy work as it prepares the next  
14 generation of advocates through youth engagement programs such as the Youth Alliance and

15 the Youth Advocacy Internship, empowering young people to use their voices to shape a  
16 more just and compassionate society; and

17 WHEREAS, on this 14th Annual Day at the state capitol, ICM's tireless commitment to  
18 ensuring that all children in Georgia have the opportunity to thrive represents a call to action  
19 for leaders, advocates, and communities across the state to continue working toward a future  
20 where every child is nurtured, protected, and given the opportunity to succeed.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
22 recognize February 11, 2025, as the Interfaith Children's Movement's 14th Annual Day at the  
23 state capitol in honor of the organization's unwavering efforts on behalf of the children of this  
24 state as well as extend best wishes for continued success.
