1 Congratulating and commending Aaliyah Phillips, Miss Cobb County 2025; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Aaliyah Phillips was crowned Miss Cobb County 2025 at the 66th annual Miss
4 Cobb County Scholarship Competition in Marietta, Georgia, a title that recognizes her
5 dedication to education, leadership, and community service; and

6 WHEREAS, she will go on to compete for the title of Miss Georgia in June 2025, the winner
7 of which will represent the State of Georgia in the Miss America Competition; and

8 WHEREAS, the Miss Cobb County Scholarship Board additionally awarded her with a
9 \$10,000 cash scholarship to support her pursuit of a Doctor of Education in education policy
10 as well as her ultimate goal of serving as the Secretary of the United States Department of
11 Education; and

12 WHEREAS, a 2024 magna cum laude graduate of Columbus State University, she earned
13 a Bachelor of Science in elementary education while maintaining consistent placement on
14 the President's List and serving as a Student Government Association senator; and

15 WHEREAS, she has further honed her leadership skills by serving as a communications
16 intern for United States Senator Jon Ossoff, training at the Ron Clark Academy, and
17 attending the Disney Dreamers Academy; and

18 WHEREAS, Aaliyah is currently in her first year as a kindergarten teacher and has dedicated
19 over 500 hours to community service, actively participating in local events as a vocalist,
20 speaker, advocate, and volunteer; and

21 WHEREAS, she further serves as the founder of SPREAD: Spreading Literacy Through
22 Reading, an initiative focused on promoting literacy equality, through which she has
23 partnered with organizations such as Girls, Inc.; United Way of Greater Atlanta; the Literacy
24 Alliance; and Cobb Collaborative, Educating, Engaging and Empowering; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this distinguished young woman be
26 appropriately honored.
