SUBJECT: State Auditor's Certification
House Bill (LC 47 3334)

Dear Representative Leverett:

This bill would amend provisions relating to retirement for certain members of the Georgia Judicial Retirement System. Currently, the normal retirement age for all members of the Georgia Judicial Retirement System is 60 years of age. This bill would increase the normal retirement age for members who hold the office of superior court judge from 60 years to 65 years of age. This change would only apply to persons who take such office on or after July 1, 2026. The normal retirement age would remain 60 years of age for any person who holds the office of superior court judge prior to the effective date.

This is to certify that this bill is a nonfiscal retirement bill as defined in the Public Retirement Systems Standards Law.
