

The House Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Affairs offers the following substitute to HB 117:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to commercial food service establishments, so as to require notification of foreign
3 imported shrimp; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 food service establishments, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

9 "26-2-378.1.

10 All commercial food service establishments in this state that serve imported shrimp shall
11 conspicuously display on their menus a disclosure by each menu item containing shrimp
12 stating 'FOREIGN IMPORTED,' or display 'FOREIGN IMPORTED SHRIMP' on placards
13 visible to the public."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
