A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 9-15, 2025, as Future Business Leaders of America Week at the state
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Future Business Leaders of America Inc. (FBLA) is a non-profit educational
4 organization whose first chapter was established in Johnson City, Tennessee, in 1942; and

5 WHEREAS, Iowa became FBLA's first state chapter in 1947; and

6 WHEREAS, Alfred Ely Beach High School officially chartered its FBLA local chapter in
7 October 1979; and

8 WHEREAS, FBLA includes more than 250,000 members and advisers in 4,600 chapters
9 nationwide in middle schools, high schools, colleges, universities, career and technical
10 schools, and private business schools; and

11 WHEREAS, FBLA is a professional business organization dedicated to bringing business
12 and education together in a positive working relationship through innovative leadership and
13 career development programs; and

14 WHEREAS, FBLA members perform community service activities and strive to build a
15 student's understanding of the realities of the modern business world; and

16 WHEREAS, FBLA teaches middle school, high school, and college students basic business
17 and leadership principles as well as assists them in the transition from school to work.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize February 9-15, 2025, as Future Business Leaders of America Week at the state
20 capitol.
