A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the Georgia Vision Alliance for its exemplary contributions to the blind and
2 visually impaired community in Georgia; and for other purposes.

4 visually impaired community, working tirelessly to advance accessibility, equality, and
5 opportunities across the state of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, this distinguished organization has demonstrated unwavering commitment to
7 creating an inclusive society where individuals with visual impairments can lead
8 independent, fulfilling, and dignified lives; and
