A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Charles Tamlin Hall Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Charles Tamlin Hall Jr. on January 20, 2025; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Charles Tamlin Hall Jr. was born on July 10, 1950, a beloved son of Tamlin and
5 Mary Nell Hall; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a proud alumnus of the University of Georgia (UGA), he was a lifelong fan of
7 the Georgia Bulldogs and served as President of the UGA College of Agricultural and
8 Environmental Sciences Alumni Association Board of Directors; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he further served as Founder and President/CEO of Association Services Group
10 (ASG) of LaGrange, Georgia, from 1995 to 2021, which was recognized many times as one
11 of the fastest growing companies in Georgia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Charles Tamlin Hall Jr. was an active member
13 of First Baptist Church on the Square, where he served as a Deacon, Greeter, and Usher for

14 over three decades and participated in the Friday Morning Bible Study Group, which he
15 attended for 45 years; and

16 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Jan, and was blessed with two
17 remarkable children, Emily and Tamlin, as well as six wonderful grandchildren, Bethany,
18 Hannah, Conner, Addison, Brock, and Hendrix; and

19 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
20 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
21 family and friends were admired by others; and

22 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
24 made this world a better place in which to live; and

25 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Charles Tamlin Hall Jr. will long be
26 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
27 had the great fortune of knowing him.
