## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Ringgold High School JROTC Tiger Guard drill team; and

3 WHEREAS, the Ringgold High School JROTC Tiger Guard drill team has established and  
4 maintained a proud tradition of excellence with equal emphases on character and academics;

6 WHEREAS, despite being the smallest team competing at the National Level, the Ringgold  
7 JROTC Tiger Guard has achieved remarkable success, winning over 50 All Army and  
8 National trophies as well as multiple region and state championships in the past eight years;

10 WHEREAS, the Ringgold JROTC Tiger Guard made history by forming the first all-female  
11 color guard to present colors at Mercedes-Benz Stadium, an accomplishment that garnered  
12 recognition in local and regional news; and

13 WHEREAS, this all-star team is led by Cadet Drill Team Commander Parell, who has been  
14 a dedicated member of the Tiger Guard since the seventh grade and competed at the National

15 Level as early as eighth grade, where she was honored with the Commanding General's coin  
16 by a two-star general from Fort Knox, Kentucky; and

17 WHEREAS, Cadet Drill Team Commander Parell has won an impressive five region titles,  
18 six state titles, two All Army Runner-Up finishes, and five national titles, including her most  
19 recent national victory last year; and

20 WHEREAS, as this magnificent team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by  
21 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is  
22 abundantly proper to call them champions.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body recognize and commend the Ringgold High School JROTC Tiger  
25 Guard drill team and extend best wishes for their continued success.
