A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Samuel Micah Moon and dedicating an interchange in his memory;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Samuel Micah Moon was born in Austell, Georgia, on March 30, 2007, the
4 beloved son of Beverly La Fleur and Shendi Moon; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Moon was a STEM student at Lithia Springs High School, with an expected
6 graduation date of 2025; and

7 WHEREAS, he had a passion for music and enjoyed spending time with his friends and
8 family, hiking, and fishing; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Moon's life was tragically cut short on March 4, 2023, when he was one
10 of ten children shot at a sweet 16 birthday party in Douglas County; and

11 WHEREAS, known for his amazing sense of humor and infectious smile, Mr. Moon will
12 long be remembered for his love of family and friendship, and this loyal son and friend will
13 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
15 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an interchange in his memory.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the interchange of Interstate 20 and State Route 92 in
18 Douglas County is dedicated as the Samuel Micah Moon Memorial Interchange.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Samuel Micah Moon
21 Memorial Interchange.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
23 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of Mr.
24 Samuel Micah Moon and to the Department of Transportation.
