

The Senate Committee on Interstate Cooperation offered the following substitute to HB 117:

MOOT

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to commercial food service establishments, so as to require notification of foreign
3 imported beef, chicken, or shrimp; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article 13 of Chapter 2 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 food service establishments, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

9 "26-2-378.1.

10 All commercial food service establishments in this state that serve imported beef, chicken,
11 or shrimp shall conspicuously display on their menus a disclosure by each menu item
12 containing beef, chicken, or shrimp stating 'FOREIGN IMPORTED,' and display
13 'FOREIGN IMPORTED MEAT' on placards visible to the public."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
