

House Bill 255 (COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 special license plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit
3 corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit
4 corporation, so as to establish a specialty license plate honoring Southern University Alumni;
5 to establish a specialty license plate honoring Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.; to provide
6 for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide for compliance with
7 constitutional requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
11 plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations with
12 proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation, is
13 amended by adding new paragraphs to subsection (l) to read as follows:

14 "(71) A special license plate honoring Southern University Alumni. The funds raised by
15 the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed to the Atlanta Metropolitan Chapter
16 of Southern University Alumni Federation of Georgia, Inc.

17 (72) A special license plate honoring Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. The funds raised
18 by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed to the Delta Life Development
19 Center."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
22 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
23 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

24 **SECTION 3.**

25 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2026.

26 **SECTION 4.**

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
