

**ADOPTED**

Senators Brass of the 6th and Summers of the 13th offered the following amendment #2:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services substitute to SB 220 (LC 33*  
 2 *9799S) by inserting between lines 340 and 341 the following:*

**SECTION 3-5A.**

3  
 4 Said chapter is further amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 16-12-230,  
 5 relating to requirements for dispensing low THC oil and products, as follows:

6 "(a) ~~Low THC oil and~~ Medical cannabis or products shall only be dispensed to registered  
 7 patients or caregivers in this state by a dispensing licensee or directly from the commission  
 8 pursuant to this article."

9 *By striking line 379 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

10 or products to a registered patient, or such patient's caregiver, parent, or guardian;

11 *By striking lines 427 and 428 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

12 forms, and annual review and recommendations, by revising paragraphs (2) and (3) of  
 13 subsection (a) as follows:

14 "(2) 'Caregiver' means:

15 (A) A the parent, guardian, or legal custodian of an individual who is less than 18 years  
 16 of age or the legal guardian of an adult;

17 (B) An adult who is designated by a patient as being an individual authorized to  
 18 provide assistance, and who is willing to provide such assistance, with purchasing,  
 19 possessing, and administering medical cannabis or products for such patient's use; or

20 (C) A healthcare institution as defined in Code Section 51-1-29.6 where a patient is  
21 receiving health or medical care for a condition and where such institution agrees to  
22 allow such patient to possess and use medical cannabis or products on such institution's  
23 premises.
