### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Constance Levett Abbott; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Constance Levett Abbott has devoted her life to ministry, serving as a  
3 leader, teacher, and spiritual guide who works to transform the lives of others through faith  
4 and service; and

5 WHEREAS, she was licensed to preach the Gospel in 1996 at First Agape Christian  
6 Fellowship Church, and she has since held numerous ministerial roles throughout her career,  
7 including serving under Pastor Keith D. Brooks at All Nations Life & Praise Church; and
