- 1 Commending Four Corners Primary Care Centers; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Four Corners Primary Care Centers (FCPC) is committed to delivering
3 comprehensive primary health care services across all stages of life, ensuring accessible,
4 high-quality care for the residents of its service area; and
- 5 WHEREAS, FCPC provides primary care, oral health, mental health, substance abuse
6 counseling, specialty care, pharmacy assistance, enabling services, education, and
7 comprehensive outreach through service delivery locations in Norcross, Lawrenceville, and
8 Hoschton; and
- 9 WHEREAS, FCPC serves all individuals regardless of language, gender, socio-economic
10 status, physical and mental capacity, age, religion, housing status, or ability to pay, with a
11 particular focus on reaching homeless, low-income, uninsured, underinsured, vulnerable,

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable organization be
19 appropriately honored during this special time.
