## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Jung Ha Kim and the Community Resource Corporation;  
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Jung Ha Kim has dedicated more than three decades to academia and  
4 nonprofit leadership, specializing in community education, program development,  
5 curriculum design, research, and advocacy; and

6 WHEREAS, she is the founder and president of the Community Resource Corporation  
7 (CRC), a nonprofit organization committed to addressing racial and gender disparities in  
8 immigrant and refugee communities; and

9 WHEREAS, the CRC has played a pivotal role in fostering community partnerships,  
10 collaborating with organizations such as the Lucky Shoals Community Association to  
11 develop dementia respite care programs and working with the Fielding School of Public  
12 Health at UCLA on the BRAVE study; and

13 WHEREAS, the CRC has further led efforts to promote cultural heritage and representation  
14 by supporting events such as the AAPI Cultural Heritage Festival in Suwanee and organizing  
15 Korean cultural performances at Georgia State University; and

16 WHEREAS, her extensive experience in nonprofit management includes serving as CEO and  
17 President of the Center for Pan Asian Community Services Inc. (CPACS), where she  
18 oversaw a budget expansion from \$11 million to \$14 million and contributed to over 20  
19 published articles, interviews, and documentaries highlighting community projects; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Jung Ha Kim has long been an advocate for social justice and equity,  
21 serving on national mentoring committees, securing grants to address intimate partner  
22 violence in immigrant communities, and working to improve data collection on Asian  
23 American health and well-being; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this distinguished leader be appropriately  
25 honored during this special time.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
27 the members of this body recognize and commend Dr. Jung Ha Kim for her invaluable  
28 contributions to community engagement, research, and nonprofit leadership as well as extend  
29 best wishes for continued success.
