## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Congresswoman Lucy McBath; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Lucy McBath has devoted her career to advocating for  
3 bipartisan solutions that address gun violence, support small businesses, strengthen the  
4 economy, protect veterans, and lower healthcare and prescription drug costs; and

5 WHEREAS, since taking office in January 2019, she has worked across party lines to  
6 advance meaningful legislation, earning recognition as an effective lawmaker and a leading  
7 voice within the House Democratic Caucus; and

8 WHEREAS, she played a key role in the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act, the first  
9 comprehensive gun safety legislation in over three decades; championed the HAVEN Act,  
10 which provides protections for veterans experiencing financial hardship; and supported a bill  
11 to limit the cost of insulin for seniors on Medicare to \$35 per month; and

12 WHEREAS, her advocacy in Congress has been shaped by her lived experiences, particularly  
13 her unwavering dedication to preventing other families from enduring the pain of losing a  
14 loved one to gun violence; and

15 WHEREAS, Congresswoman McBath has proudly represented metro Atlanta in Georgia's  
16 Sixth Congressional District, working diligently to uplift and protect the communities she  
17 serves through meaningful policy and action; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
19 remarkable and distinguished individual be appropriately honored.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body recognize and commend Congresswoman Lucy McBath for her  
22 efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service as well as extend the most sincere
