

House Bill 760

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners of Glynn County, approved  
2 February 11, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937, p. 1336), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
3 April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 3914), so as to change the annual salary of the chairperson  
4 and members of the board; to provide for withholding of compensation for certain meeting  
5 absences; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting  
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act creating a board of commissioners of Glynn County, approved February 11, 1937  
10 (Ga. L. 1937, p. 1336), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L.  
11 2001, p. 3914), is amended by striking the first unnumbered paragraph of Section 6 and  
12 inserting in its place the following:

13 "The chairperson shall receive an annual salary of \$28,000.00, payable in monthly  
14 installments, and an expense allowance of \$600.00 per month. The vice chairperson shall  
15 receive an annual salary of \$27,000.00, payable in monthly installments, and an expense  
16 allowance of \$600.00 per month. Each other member of the board shall receive an annual

17 salary of \$26,000.00, payable in monthly installments, and an expense allowance of  
18 \$550.00 per month. However, that compensation shall not be paid to the chairperson, vice  
19 chairperson, or other member of the board for any month in which the chairperson, vice  
20 chairperson, or other member of the board failed to attend at least one regularly scheduled  
21 meeting of the board unless the board by majority vote determines that the absence should  
22 be excused for illness or other good cause."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2025.

25 **SECTION 3.**

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
