1 Congratulating and commending Kornisha McGill Brown for receiving the 2025 Yellow
2 Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leadership Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American
4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Women's Legislative Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Women's Legislative
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Kornisha McGill Brown has devoted her professional and personal life to
11 supporting and advocating for youth and families in her community, drawing on her
12 experience as an educator to uplift and empower others; and

13 WHEREAS, she holds distinction as the immediate past national president of Jack and Jill
14 of America, Incorporated, where she was one of only a few national presidents to serve
15 consecutive terms in the organization's 87-year history; and

16 WHEREAS, her leadership and membership extends to The Links, Incorporated; Alpha
17 Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated; and the boards of the Boys and Girls Clubs of the
18 Chattahoochee Valley, Brookstone School, and Emanuel Preparatory School; and

19 WHEREAS, she is a graduate of Spelman College with a Bachelor of Arts in political
20 science and the University of Georgia with a Master of Education; and

21 WHEREAS, she has been widely recognized for her exemplary service, receiving an official
22 commendation from Senator Jon Ossoff for her advocacy on behalf of Georgia's families as
23 well as the Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award and special recognition from the
24 Biden-Harris Administration for her dedication to serving children and families; and

25 WHEREAS, Kornisha McGill Brown resides in Columbus, Georgia, with her husband, Dr.
26 Darius K. Brown Sr., and their children, Jordan Janay Brown and Darius Brown Jr.; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

30 the members of this body congratulate and commend Kornisha McGill Brown for receiving
