1 Congratulating and commending Keysha J. Porter for receiving the 2025 Yellow Rose Nikki
2 T. Randall Servant Leadership Award; and for other purposes.

4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Women's Legislative Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Women's Legislative
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Keysha J. Porter has built an exceptional career spanning more than two
11 decades in human resources and communications, contributing her expertise across the
12 healthcare, technology, banking, and government sectors; and

13 WHEREAS, she began her professional journey in the banking industry, refining her skills
14 in HR technology and risk management before transitioning to roles as a federal contractor

15 supporting the United States Navy, United States Marines, and the federal departments of
16 Energy, Defense, and Health and Human Services; and

17 WHEREAS, she continued her impactful career by advancing leadership development
18 initiatives in the nonprofit sector, serving as the learning & development manager for (RED)
19 in New York City and The ONE Campaign in Washington, D.C.; and

20 WHEREAS, upon returning to her hometown of Atlanta, she took on her current role at
21 Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, where she is responsible for designing and implementing
22 educational initiatives that enhance the skills and knowledge of healthcare professionals; and

23 WHEREAS, deeply committed to civic engagement, Keysha J. Porter has further facilitated
24 financial literacy education for students in Junior Achievement of Atlanta, providing
25 mentorship programs for students in Atlanta Public Schools and the Coretta Scott King
26 Young Women's Leadership Academy; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body congratulate and commend Keysha J. Porter for receiving the 2025
