## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Community EsTr(EI/La); and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Community Estr(EI/La) is a grassroots organization led by immigrant,  
3 Spanish-speaking (Black, Indigenous, Brown), and transgender individuals who are  
4 dedicated to defending, organizing, and empowering the human rights of transgender  
5 Georgians; and
- 6 WHEREAS, this organization provides vital programs and services to support transgender  
7 and queer individuals, including healthcare access, HIV prevention, referrals for hormone  
8 replacement therapy, and advocacy for labor rights and protections; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Community EsTr(EI/La) fosters empowerment and education through initiatives  
10 such as the Trans Queer School, which offers English classes for members and clients, and  
11 a monthly newsletter that highlights the organization's efforts; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the organization plays a key role in social and political advocacy, engaging in  
13 mobilization efforts, legislative initiatives, and community-based actions to defend the rights  
14 of transgender individuals and immigrants; and

15 WHEREAS, through cultural empowerment, leadership development, and intervention  
16 programs, Community EsTr(EI/La) provides safe spaces for training, collaboration, and  
17 organizing, strengthening the resilience and self-determination of the transgender and gender  
18 non-conforming community; and

19 WHEREAS, Trans Liberation Day is a significant observance dedicated to recognizing the  
20 struggles and celebrating the achievements of the transgender community, and Community  
21 EsTr(EI/La) continues to be an essential force in advancing justice, equity, and visibility for  
22 transgender Georgians.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body commend Community EsTr(EI/La) upon this year's Trans  
25 Liberation Day for its dedication to advancing the rights and well-being of transgender and  
26 gender non-conforming individuals as well as extend best wishes for continued success.
