## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the National Coalition of 100 Black Women Inc. and the 100 Black Men of  
2 America Inc. and recognizing March 25, 2025, as their Joint Day at the Georgia State  
3 Capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the National Coalition of 100 Black Women Inc. (NCBW100) and the 100  
5 Black Men of America Inc. are two of the nation's most esteemed advocacy and mentorship  
6 organizations, committed to advancing equity, education, and economic empowerment for  
7 African Americans; and

8 WHEREAS, the National Coalition of 100 Black Women Inc., under the esteemed leadership  
9 of National President Virginia Harris, has dedicated itself to empowering Black women and  
10 girls through education, health, economic development, and civic engagement through its  
11 Georgia-based chapters, including the Decatur DeKalb Chapter, MECCA Chapter,  
12 Metropolitan Atlanta Chapter, Northwest Georgia Chapter, Savannah Chapter, and Stone  
13 Mountain Lithonia Chapter; and

14 WHEREAS, the Stone Mountain Lithonia Chapter of NCBW100 is serving as the host  
15 chapter for this occasion with Cecilia Anderson as its president and under the leadership of

16 Dr. Dee Dawkins-Haigler as the chair of the event, with Teresa Hardy and Frieda Aiden  
17 serving as co-chairs; and

18 WHEREAS, the 100 Black Men of America Inc., led by Chairman of the Board Milton H.  
19 Jones Jr., has made an immeasurable impact in mentoring and uplifting young African  
20 American men through its Georgia-based chapters, including the 100 Black Men of Albany  
21 Southwest Georgia Inc.; 100 Black Men of Atlanta Inc.; 100 Black Men of Augusta Inc.; 100  
22 Black Men of Columbus, GA, Inc.; 100 Black Men of DeKalb Inc.; 100 Black Men of  
23 Douglasville Inc.; 100 Black Men of Macon-Middle Inc.; 100 Black Men of  
24 Milledgeville-Oconee Inc.; 100 Black Men of New Rock Georgia Inc.; 100 Black Men of  
25 North Metro Inc.; 100 Black Men of Rome-NW GA Inc.; 100 Black Men of Savannah Inc.;  
26 100 Black Men of South Metro Inc.; 100 Black Men of Southeast GA Inc.; 100 Black Men  
27 of Valdosta Inc.; 100 Black Men of Warner Robins Inc.; and 100 Black Men of West

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
30 the members of this body commend the National Coalition of 100 Black Women Inc. and the  
31 100 Black Men of America Inc. for their continued dedication and invaluable contributions  
32 and recognize March 25, 2025, as their Joint Day at the Georgia State Capitol.
