A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Tricia Gephardt; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Tricia Gephardt has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to service,
3 leadership, and community engagement through her extensive volunteer work and
4 professional experience; and
- 5 WHEREAS, she holds a Bachelor of Arts in government from Georgetown University,
6 where she cultivated a deep understanding of public service and civic responsibility; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Tricia began her career in public service by working on Capitol Hill in
8 Washington, D.C., for the House Majority Leader, gaining invaluable experience in
9 government operations and legislative affairs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she has further contributed to the democratic process by lending her talents to
11 state and local political campaigns in Georgia, helping to foster civic engagement and
12 informed participation in the electoral process; and

13 WHEREAS, as a dedicated stay-at-home mother, she has continued to lead and serve,
14 demonstrating the profound impact of volunteerism on the strength and well-being of our
15 communities; and

16 WHEREAS, Tricia has made significant contributions to education and youth development,
17 serving as the Parents' Association president at Holy Innocents' Episcopal School and as an
18 advisory council member for Horizons Atlanta, where she worked to enhance educational
19 opportunities for children, in addition to her longtime commitment to supporting the
20 nonprofit CURE, which is dedicated to conquering childhood cancer; and

21 WHEREAS, her commitment to civic engagement led her to found The Postcard Project, a
22 grassroots initiative designed to foster meaningful dialogue, increase voter participation, and
23 encourage community involvement; and

24 WHEREAS, Tricia's tireless efforts exemplify the highest ideals of service and civic
25 leadership, inspiring others to take an active role in strengthening their communities.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 recognize and commend Tricia Gephardt for her dedication to public service, her leadership
28 in education and community engagement, and her enduring contributions to the State of
29 Georgia.
