A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Cary Williams, Jr., and dedicating a road in his honor; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Cary Williams, Jr., has long been recognized by the citizens of this state
4 for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Williams has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of
7 his time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service as an editor and publisher of the Greensboro
9 newspaper, *The Herald-Journal*; and

10 WHEREAS, a leader of the Athens community, Mr. Williams' significant organizational and
11 leadership talents, his remarkable patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his
12 sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state have earned him the respect and
13 admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
15 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his honor.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 15 from mile marker 241.62 to
18 mile marker 247.64 in Greene and Oconee counties is dedicated as the Cary Williams, Jr.
19 Highway.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Cary Williams, Jr. Highway.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
23 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr. Cary Williams,
24 Jr., and to the Department of Transportation.
